

FULL TILT CLASSIC SET TO TAKE TOURNAMENT POKER BACK TO BASICS THIS FEBRUARY

Full Tilt launches new 16-event freezeout championship over eight days

ONCHAN, Isle of Man – February 5th, 2015 – Full Tilt is going back to basics from February 15th-22nd with the launch of the Full Tilt Classic – an online championship of poker in its purest form, comprising 16 freezeout tournaments across eight days of action.

The series features two daily deep-stack freezeouts – one No Limit Hold'em event and one alternative game type – with direct buy-ins on the first day of the series set at just \$0.50. As the series progresses the buy-ins will increase, culminating in the \$100 Main Event on Sunday, February 22nd, with at least \$200,000 on the line.

The new series is being launched in conjunction with a complete update to the Full Tilt tournament offering. Buy-ins have been standardized for Multi-Table Tournaments and Sit & Gos, and a range of new satellites have been added to the schedule. The Full Tilt Classic will showcase the variety on offer to players. Check out the full schedule below.
