

FULL TILT GUARANTEES \$4 MILLION FOR FTOPS XXVIII

March series features 35 events over 15 days – satellites now running

ONCHAN, Isle of Man – February 13th, 2015 – The Full Tilt Online Poker Series (FTOPS) is set to return from March 15th through March 29th, featuring 35 events over 15 days of intense tournament action, and boasting a guaranteed prize pool of \$4 million. Daily satellites are already under way, with buy-ins starting from just \$0.11 or 100 Full Tilt Points.

FTOPS XXVIII kicks off on Sunday, March 15th with at least \$500,000 to play for in two No Limit Hold'em events, and finishes on March 29th with a \$1,000 buy-in Main Event, which has a \$1 million guarantee.

Other highlights include an NL Hold'em Rush Rebuy tournament with \$75,000 guaranteed (Event #14), a \$2,500 buy-in two-day NL Hold'em tournament with \$350,000 guaranteed (Event #15), and for mixed game fans, ML 10-Game (Event #11) and ML 25-Game (Event #30) events — both 6-max — that feature \$50,000 and \$25,000 guaranteed prize pools, respectively.
