

# POKERSTARS LAUNCHES 'CARNIVAL OF TOURNAMENTS' TO CELEBRATE TOURNAMENT NUMBER 800 MILLION

ONCHAN, Isle of Man – October 8, 2013 – PokerStars will celebrate another industry milestone later this month when the world's largest online poker site marks tournament number 800 million. To commemorate the achievement, PokerStars has announced the <u>Carnival of Tournaments: 800 Million Celebration</u>, a player promotion that will take place at PokerStars from October 13-20.

The promotion will mark tournament number 800 million, and reinforce PokerStars' position as the 'home of tournament poker', with more than \$2 million in boosted guarantees, \$700,000 in added giveaway prizes, and other special tournaments.

PokerStars is recognized as having popularized online tournament play and in 2002 launched the most prestigious online tournament: the World Championship of Online Poker, which to date has awarded more than \$385 million to players.

The modern poker boom can be traced to a PokerStars online tournament, when Chris Moneymaker qualified for the World Series of Poker on PokerStars and went on to become World Champion in Las Vegas for \$2.5 million. In 2006, PokerStars was also the first site to host a weekly \$1 million guaranteed tournament – the Sunday Million.

### Other key tournament achievements:

- In December 2011, PokerStars held the richest ever online poker tournament during its 10th Anniversary Celebration, with a \$12,423,200 million prize pool
- In April 2013 the Spring Championship of Online Poker 2013 became the richest ever online poker tournament festival with over \$75 million awarded to players
- In June 2013 PokerStars set a new Guinness World Record for Largest Ever
   Online Poker Tournament, after 225,000 players participated in the \$1 event

### **TOURNAMENT NUMBER 800 MILLION**

The focal point of the latest milestone celebration is tournament number '800 Million', which is to be played on October 20 at 13.00 ET and will feature a \$109 buy-in, \$1 million guarantee, and \$100,000 given out in added prizes to random tables for the first two hours of the tourney. Satellites have already started and players can qualify from just \$1. ### **BIG, BIGGER, BIGGEST**

Before that tourney kicks off though, players can enjoy a week of \$2 million in increased guarantees in the daily 'Big' tournaments.

- **Big** from October 14-18 all Big tournaments will have their guarantees increased by 50%
- Bigger on October 19 all Big tournaments will have their guarantees doubled
- Biggest on October 20 all Big tournaments will have their guarantees tripled

All the Big tournaments will also feature additional 'bubble ticket prizes', with over \$100,000 set to be given away during the week.

## THE RETURN OF GOLDEN SIT & GO'S

Following a successful and popular run during the 100 Billion Hands Celebration earlier this year, PokerStars will fire up some more Golden Sit & Go's from October 13-19, with \$500,000 in cash rewards to give away. Any player who registers for a Sit & Go can win, with bonuses handed out to random SNG tournaments as follows:

- **Big** player gets 2x buy-in of the SNG, table prize pool is doubled
- Bigger player gets 3x buy-in of the SNG, table prize pool is tripled
- Biggest player gets 5x buy-in of the SNG, table prize pool is quintupled
