

POKERSTARS OBTAINS SPORTS BETTING LICENCE IN DENMARK

ONCHAN, Isle of Man – December 4, 2015 – Danes will soon be able to enjoy the thrill of betting on sports in Denmark on PokerStars, an Amaya Inc. (Nasdaq: AYA; TSX: AYA) brand.
