

# POKERSTARS TAKES OVER LATIN AMERICA IN MARCH WITH DOUBLE DOWN ON SPONSORED LIVE EVENTS

Earlier this month in Uruguay, Akkari made his first appearance on a BSOP Main Event final table, having narrowly missed out a few times before, at Punta del Este. The Team PokerStars Pro finished in seventh place when his AQ lost out to pocket threes leaving him with \$15,340 for his efforts.

He said: "I felt really proud to make it to the final table of BSOP Uruguay, especially as BSOP is the biggest tournament in Latin America and brings great players to the felt.

Playing in BSOP is like playing at the Maracanã Stadium for me. In São Paulo, with my supporters, I'll take it down and keep the BSOP São Paulo title at home!"
